**Please indicate the number of times police were called to reports of violence in a crowd at a boxing match/fight night event.**

**Please give details of reasons for being called out. Was it crowd violence, drunk and disorderly, possessing drugs or offensive weapons?**

**Please indicate how many people arrested.**

**Please provide figures for calendar years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018 so far.**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

**Response –** Please see the below table detailing the information you have requested.

Year	District	Description
2015	Three Rivers	Boxing Match lots of rowdy people outside. On police arrival all people has left the area
2015	Hertsmere	60-70 males in car park for unauthorised boxing match. Males had left before police arrival
2016	East Herts	Large group outside after boxing match. Parties had left before police arrival.
2017	Stevenage	2 males fighting in lift after watching boxing match in hotel. Were just two friends being rowdy.
2017	Stevenage	Group of rowdy male in street. 4 males excited after boxing match
2017	Welwyn/Hatfield	Boxing match at The Forum. IP punched in head. Treated by private ambulance at event. Taken to hospital. IP refused to give an account
2018	Dacorum	Call stated charity boxing match. People attacking door staff. Officers arrived and CCTV showed people being ejected from venue and pushing and shoving as they left
2018	Welwyn/Hatfield	Boxing match. Security stated male started getting rowdy with bar staff and asked to leave.
