I write in connection with your request for information received on 23rd July. I note you seek access to the following information:

I request disclosure of information under the freedom of information act.

I am writing to request anonymous information about domestic violence crimes where the victim is aged 60 and over that have been reported and recorded by your constabulary.

1. Please could you state the annual total number of domestic violence crimes recorded where the victim is aged 60 and over during each of the 2015, 2016, 2017 calendar years and this year to date.

For each crime you have recorded in the annual totals, please could you provide a further breakdown including;

Age of victim at the time of the offence Age of perpetrator at the time of the offence Gender of perpetrator Gender of victim Relationship of PERPETRATOR to the victim

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Please note that the 'Offender/Perpetrator' details are only available where there is a linked arrest record. In some cases the relationship between offender and victim are unknown as they cannot be ascertained from the crime text which I have manually checked on CIS. In some case, there are relationship details but no offender details, this could be where no arrest was made due to the victim being unsupportive.

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
