I write in connection with your request for information received on 3rd August. I note you seek access to the following information:

Taking the combined total for the 2015, 2016 and 2017 calendar years, which three fixed position camera sites in your area were responsible for (i) the issuing of the most fixed penalty notices to suspected speeders and (ii) were activated the most time by speeding vehicles?

Please provide me with the position of each of the three cameras and the number of FPNs issued as a result of it "catching" suspected speeders in that three year period as well as the number of activations logged at that site.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
