I write in connection with your request for information received on 19th November. I note you seek access to the following information:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information:

- 1. How much money did the force spend on providing gender neutral facilities for staff in the year 1/11/17 to 1/11/18**
- 2. How much money did the force spend on providing gender neutral facilities for staff in the year 1/11/16 to 1/11/17**

By providing gender neutral facilities I include the costs of construction works undertaken to create facilities such as gender neutral toilets.

By staff I am including both civilian employees and officers

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
