I write in connection with your request for information received on 25th November. I note you seek access to the following information:

1) The number of incidents you have responded to where "Tinder" was mentioned on the callout record as part of the incident, in each calendar year from 2014 to 2018 inclusive, broken down by calendar year (I appreciate that 2018 may not have a full calendar year's worth of results, but would appreciate the data year to date).

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response – Searches have been made on all incident logs containing 'tinder' in the log, text or detail fields for the last five years. After removing any obvious names/roads/other unrelated references to 'tinder', those that appear to match this request and mention Tinder in one way or another as follows:

2014 – 5
2015 – 15
2016 – 35
2017 – 41
2018 – 55 (to 9th December)
