I write in connection with your request for information received on 24th January. I note you seek access to the following information:

Please provide the following information:

- 1) Do Police Officer's receive any free or discounted train travel?
- 2) If so, with which train company and with what conditions?
- 3) Does your force make any payment to the train company for this concession?
- 4) Does the Police Officer's make any payment for this concession?
- 5) Please provide any written agreement between the force and any train operating company relating to travel concessions.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response – Following your request, searches were conducted at Hertfordshire Constabulary for information relating to free or discounted train travel. If there were any agreement in place it would be arranged through the Hertfordshire Police Federation.

These searches failed to locate any records / documents relevant to your request. Accordingly I have determined that Hertfordshire Constabulary do not hold the information you have requested.
