I write in connection with your request for information received on 1st June. I note you seek access to the following information:

Your response of 25.4.18 to request FOI2018/01789 stated, "Please note that we have a 6-8 week turnaround on ticket entries once received within our Cameras, Tickets and Collisions Department, therefore the figures for February and March 2018 may differ". In accordance with my email of 26.4.18 in reply to this response, may I therefore request updated figures for the same information, as follows: A single combined total for the number of Fixed Penalty Notices and Traffic Offence Reports (as applicable) issued during 2017/18 for the offence of cycling on a footway (under section 72 of the Highways Act 1835), broken down if possible into sub-totals for: • fines paid, • fines/FPNs/TORs cancelled, • cases referred to Court for prosecution and/or recipients of TORs opted for court proceedings, • cases disposed of in any other way, and • cases with resolution still outstanding.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response – Our data analysts have run the report again and there were no additional offences to add to the 2017/18 figures previously provided.
