Do you have a policy which covers the administration of police injury awards/pensions?

I am looking for anything which is a policy on how injury awards/pensions are managed, particularly how any reviews of degree of disablement should be handled.

If you have anything, then I would like a copy please.

Also, please tell me the name of the doctor or doctors who the police pension authority uses to make decisions regarding police injury awards/pensions.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Response; Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire Constabulary are a collaborated Information Management department and the response below is on behalf of both Forces;

Please see the attached FOI2018/01777 Annexe A document which is the Ill Health Retirement – Police Officers policy and relevant to your request. There are no reviews of degree of disablement.

Industrial, Medical and Safety Services (IMASS) Occupational Health Solutions are used by both Forces. Further information cannot be provided as such information is exempt under Section 40 – Personal Information of the Freedom of Information Act.
