I write in connection with your request for information received on 26th October. I note you seek access to the following information:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information:

Please can you provide me with details of all the burglaries on non-residential premises reported to your force in the most recent 12-month period available, which have involved the theft or attempted theft of an ATM (cash machine).

Within that time period, I would like you to include all reported crimes recorded under the return codes 30D Attempted Burglary - Business and Community, 30C Burglary - Business and Community, or 31A Aggravated Burglary - Business and Community.

In each case, I'd like to know:

- 1) When it happened**
- 2) Where it happened and, if possible, the name of the business**
- 3) Whether any suspects were charged or summonsed**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response – In the time period 01/11/2017 – 31/10/2017 there has been 1 recorded offence of Attempted Burglary – Business and Community and 1 recorded offence of Burglary – Business and Community. One offence took place in Three Rivers CSP and the other in St Albans CSP. 1 offence was committed in July 2018 and 1 in August 2018.

There have been no suspects charged or summonsed to date.

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
