I write in connection with your request for information received on 1st November. I note you seek access to the following information:

Can I find out the below information under the Fol Act please?

1. How many crimes involving 'wolf whistling' have been reported to your force in 2017? 2018? (I.e. where the term 'wolf whistling' has been mentioned in the MO field of a crime report?)

2. If possible and within the cost limit, of these reported crimes can I find out how many led to convictions?

To clarify, if question 2 takes the request over cost limit, or you cannot find that information out, then please can I find out the answer to question 1 alone please?

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response – There are no crimes which match the criteria of having either the term 'wolf whistling', 'wolf whistled', 'wolf whistles' or 'wolf whistle' mentioned within the MO text for the period concerned.
