I write in connection with your request for information received on 5th November. I note you seek access to the following information:

I'd like to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act about driving license fines.

Would it be possible to find out how many people were fined by Hertfordshire Constabulary for having incorrect information on their driving licenses over the last 5 tax years (or a similar timeframe). Could this be broken down into the following categories (in order of priority if not all are possible):

- **Having an incorrect address on their driving license**
- **Having an incorrect name on their driving license, for example a maiden name**
- **Owning multiple driving licenses**
- **Driving with an out-of-date license**
- **Having an out-of-date photo on their driving license**
- **Having an incorrect date of birth on their driving license**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following your request, searches were conducted at Hertfordshire Constabulary for information relating to incorrect driving license fines. I can that these are all DVLA offences and are not handled by the police. Accordingly I have determined that Hertfordshire Constabulary do not hold the information you have requested.
