I write in connection with your request for information received on 10th September. I note you seek access to the following information:

**Under the Freedom of Information Act please can I request information about:
How many people aged 80 and older have been on a speed awareness course in the last five years?
Please could it also include how many of those are female and how many are male.**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

Response

- In Hertfordshire so far in 2018 106 people aged 80 and above completed speed awareness (NSAC or NSAC 20) course.
The gender split was: Males: 90; Females: 44 Unknown: 1
- In Hertfordshire in 2017 1,031 people aged 80 and above completed a speed awareness (NSAC or NSAC 20) course.
The gender split was: Males: 678; Females: 326 Unknown: 27
- In Hertfordshire in 2016 1,339 people aged 80 and above completed a speed awareness (NSAC or NSAC 20) course.
The gender split was: Males: 906 Females: 393 Unknown: 40

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
