I write in connection with your request for information received on 26th September. I note you seek access to the following information:

**Theft from vans in Stevenage, SG2 area.**

**Statistics on how many vans have been broken into and tools stolen. Please provide the MO if recorded.**

**For the period 10 September - 15 September 2018.**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

**Response** – Two offences have been located that relate to your request, between those dates in the SG2 postcode area. Please see the MO's provided below;

1. "Between material times, the offender(s) have broken off the dead locks; with an unknown tool and have gain enters to the rear of the van and have taken power tools". This one relates to a van and lists a drill as being stolen.
2. "BETWEEN MATERIAL TIMES OFFENDER HAS ENTERED THE LOCKED VEHICLE BY MEANS UNKNOWN AND REMOVED ITEMS AND MADE OFF IN DIRECTION UNKNOWN"
