I write in connection with your request for information received on 2nd October. I note you seek access to the following information:

I wish to place an FOI request with Hertfordshire Constabulary in relation to incidents involving Deliveroo drivers. Within the last three years, from October 2015 until October 2018, how many road traffic incidents across Hertfordshire have involved either a Deliveroo driver, cyclist or moped rider? We would appreciate the information in relation to a feature we're working on. I would appreciate if your response could include the date of the incident, location, type of vehicle involve, the severity of the incident (injuries/fatalities) and if further action was taken.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Response – Hertfordshire Constabulary do not hold the requested information. When a collision is recorded the information includes driver name and address (if the vehicles is owned by someone else) but not employer.

As Deliveroo drivers are self-employed all vehicles would be in the names of individuals not the company. This means that we have no way of tracking if any Deliveroo drivers/cyclists have been involved in collisions.
