**Could you please provide, for M25 motorway, westbound, junction 21 to 20 at marker post 5219B on 01st August 2018 the following information For each recorded offence of Contravene Red Automatic Traffic Signal(Motorway) recorded by camera on 01st August 2018 at M25 motorway, westbound, junction 21 to 20 at marker post 5219B, could you provide the time of the offence, which lanes were closed, the time the lane closed and the time it reopened. Please also provided any photographic evidence that supports this.**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Constabulary please see our response below.

**Response –** Hertfordshire Constabulary do not hold the information that has been requested. Only Highways England knows when the red X is turned on and off. Hertfordshire Constabulary do not have a Red X enforcement camera between junction 21 and 20 on the M25.
