**REQUEST UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 Ref No: FOI2018/04884**

I write in connection with your request for information received on 29th August. I note you seek access to the following information:

**I refer to your reply of 6th March 2018, in which you stated that of the 20 investigated hate crimes that have been committed against transgender people/persons with the protected characteristic of gender reassignment, there have been two arrests and one charge. The purpose of this FOI request is to establish the outcomes of the 17 reported hate crimes, from the initial 20, that did not result in an arrest or a charge. The outcomes will be from the list of 21 Home Office crime outcomes.**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
